Learning Activities					Supports	
Activate Learning: Introduce a sock puppet and describe its personality and show an example of its Puppet Personality Profile. Ask students to share ideas about the sock puppets they would like to create.						



Activities:

- Hand out Puppet Personality Profile Booklet.
- Students create a Puppet personality profile for their sock puppet.

Materials:

• Puppet Personality Profile Booklet.

-Have example statements of each level on the board, such as 'My puppet likes sports, drawing, daydreaming, animals, pizza etc."

-"My puppet is outgoing, shy, a trouble-maker, creative, a good friend, a kind big brother, etc.)

-Have a generic list of personality traits in case students have trouble coming up with ideas.

Closure:

 Gather the students together and ask them to share ideas as a whole class discussion- Share what they noticed and learned.
